The Ni Ti Mountain Wind Project is an Indigenous community-led initiative on Yinka Dene territory, near Fraser Lake, BC. Majority-owned by the Stellat'en First Nation and Nadleh Whut'en collectively and developed in partnership with Innergex, the project will generate clean, renewable electricity while bringing long-term benefits and opportunities to the community.

Building the Ni Ti Mountain Wind Project will require a strong, skilled workforce, from entry-level workers to experienced tradespeople, technicians, and project leaders.

To support this effort, a wide range of training opportunities are available across British Columbia. Programs range from short safety certifications completed in just a few days, to comprehensive trades and professional programs lasting several months or more.

Whether you are starting your career, upgrading your skills, or looking to transition into the renewable energy sector, training options are accessible and designed to meet a variety of needs.

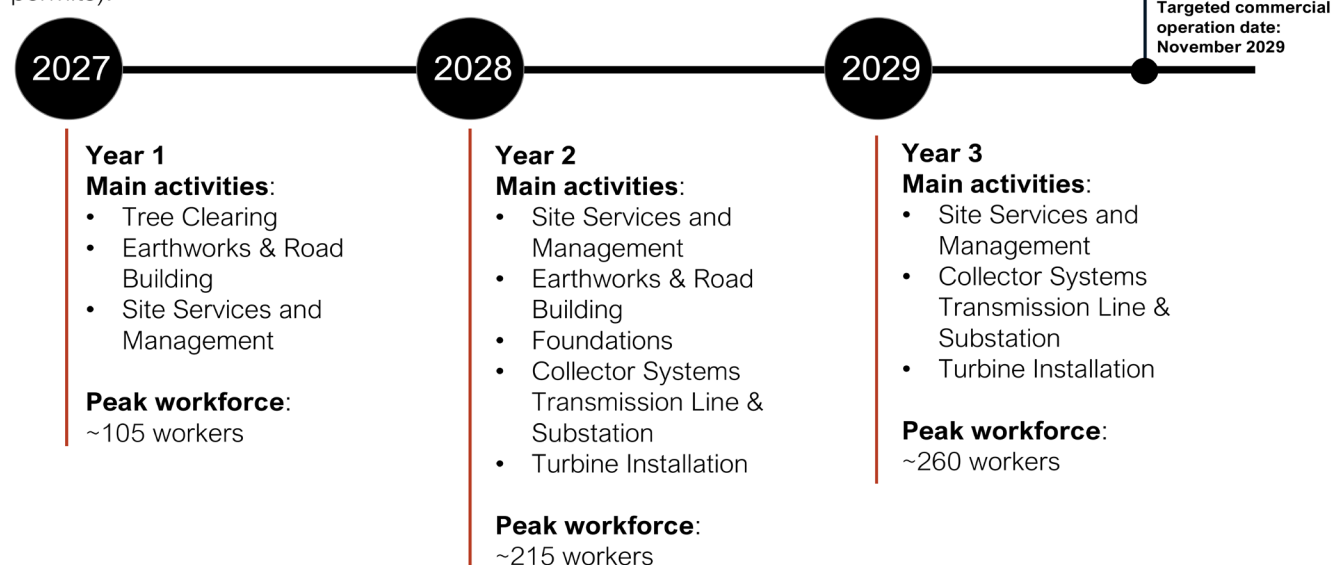
